## REQUIREMENTS FOR IMMIGRANT VISA

Applicants for an immigrant visa to the Philippines are requested to **comply strictly** with the following documentary requirements:

- 1. Duly accomplished Application Form (FA Form No.3) to be filed in duplicate.
- 2. 2. The applicant's passport which should have a validity of at least one (1) year at the time of application.
- 3. **Original** copy of the Official Birth Certificate and two (2) photocopies thereof.
- 4. Police Clearance/Record of a Law Enforcement Information issued by the National Police authority of the country of residence. **Original** and two (2) photocopies.
- 5. One (1) **original** and two (2) photocopies of the Medical Examination Report (DFA Form No. 11), together with the following documentation of medical examination results:
  - a. Chest X-ray for those aged 11 years and above. The X-ray film/cd should be presented and submitted together with the application.
  - b. Laboratory Examination:
    - i. Blood Serolory for those aged 15 years and above
    - ii. Urine for those aged 15 years and above
    - iii. Stool for those aged 1 year and above
    - iv. Other laboratory examinations, if necessary

The **original** copies of the laboratory examination results should be attached to the application.

- 6. Evidence of Financial capacity (one (1) **original** and two (2) photocopies). The documents to be presented under this requirement are: (1.) Proof of personal properties, which may be cash, bank accounts, or investments either in the country of residence or in the Philippines and/or (2.) Proof of ownership of real estate properties either in the country of residence or in the Philippines.
- 7. Four (4) passport size photographs of the applicant.
- 8. One (1) **original** and three (3) photocopies of the Marriage Contract if the applicant is married to a Filipino citizen or a former Filipino citizen (if applicable)
- 9. If the applicant is married to a Filipino Citizen, the Philippine passport of the Filipino spouse should be enclosed with the application.
  - If the applicant is married to a former Filipino citizen, the last Philippine passport of the former Filipino should be enclosed with the applicant.
  - If the applicant is a former Filipino Citizen, the last Philippine passport should be enclosed with the application.
- 10. Payment of visa fee in the amount of NZ\$210.00 per applicant. Payment could be made either in *cash* or *in bank cheque/bank draft* payable to the Embassy of the Philippines.
- 11. A self-addressed stamped envelope or a pre-paid courier bag that will fit the X-ray Film/cd for the return of the application and its supporting documents.
- 12. All applicants, except former Filipinos, should call the Embassy to arrange an appointment for a personal appearance and interview with the Consular Officer at the Embassy.
  - Applicants who are former Filipinos, while not required to personally appear at the Embassy, shall be required to undergo the interview by telephone. They should call the Embassy to schedule such an interview.
